

**BYLAW 9:2011
VILLAGE OF FORESTBURG
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

A bylaw of the Village of Forestburg, in the Province of Alberta to set Water, Sewer and Garbage Rates Bylaw, pursuant to Section 7 and Section 8 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 Chapter M-26, amendments thereto, Providing for a Bylaw Respecting Management and Conduct of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Forestburg may enact bylaws regulating the provision of public utility services rates;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of section 63 & 64 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto a Council may pass an amending Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Village of Forestburg Council enacts as follows:

a) Water Monthly Rate as follows:

Residences and Churches	\$22.00	18.18 cubic metres
** Overage rate where applicable is \$1.10 per cubic metre

d) Disconnection/Reconnection Fee:

- i) The disconnection fee will be charged when a disconnection is requested either by the property owner or the Village for non-payment of utility charges.
- ii) The reconnection fee plus any outstanding balance must be paid in full prior to the service being reconnected.

Bylaw 7:2011 is hereby rescinded.


This bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the date of third and final reading and rate increases will commence with the January, 2012 Utility Billing.
