

PROPOSED ENHANCEMENT STRATEGY FOR THE FORESTBURG CEMETERY

- 1) Create a development plan that identifies the following:
 - Memorial Bench placement
 - a. One (1) or two (2) along center driveway one facing north the other south
 - b. In the reflection gardens possibly 4 per garden
 - c. One in the scattering garden
 - Memorial tree/shrub planting plan
 - a. Shrubs - Around the raised beds of the scattering garden and within the reflection gardens
 - b. Trees around the perimeter of the cemetery
 - Make the existing park area on the south side more user friendly reflection garden:
 - Remove the spruce tree in the center of the area
 - Place ground cloth and bark chips around all plants
 - Provide location allotments for memorial benches
 - Provide locations allotments for potential adornments such as statues or other ornaments
 - Create another reflection garden in the Northeast section of the cemetery:
 - Section “E” at the intersection of walkways by plots 24, 25, 40, & 41
 - Place ground cloth and bark chips around all plants
 - Provide spots for memorial benches
 - Provide locations allotments for potential adornments such as statues or other ornaments
 - Create a “Scattering Garden” for cremation burials in the Southeast corner of the existing south side (see attached concept)
 - Provide row locators for the alignment of interment plots
 - Consider the cessation of the practice of head to toe plots in favor of row of plots, walkway, row of plots
 - Create a 5 year plan which identifies a specific section for improvement in which:
 1. Grave covers in disrepair or alignment are removed
 2. Unmarked graves or those affected by (1) above, are provided with a permanent marker
 3. align head stones within a row of existing stones (not the plot itself) to facilitate easier maintenance

- Provide Section and row markers and a map or alphabetical listing of graves as a visitor plot locator guide

- Pursue the potential for north side expansion of the existing cemetery
